
Q5 When you think of "Christian values" which two candidates come to mind first?



Q6 Former Starbucks CEO Howard Schultz is Exploring an Independent Candidacy. Would you consider voting for him?





Q7 Which of the following would you be most likely to vote for as a third party candidate?





Q8 How important is a candidate's faith to you?









Q12 What is your gender?





Q13 Are you White, Black or African-American, American Indian or Alaskan Native, Asian, Native Hawaiian or other Pacific islander, or some other race?




